Techniques: Ladder Stitch & Fringe

Materials List

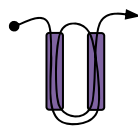
- 1-2 grams 15/o seed beads
- 10-12 grams 6mm liquid silver bugle beads
- 2 hole magnetic fold-over clasp
- 6# Fireline

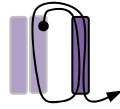
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Instructions

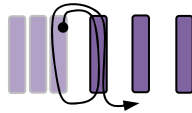
1. On a comfortable length of Fireline, string 2 bugle beads leaving a 6" tail. Pass through both bugle beads again. The bugles need to sit snugly together.



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2. Pick up another bugle and pass through the last bugle and the one just picked up again.



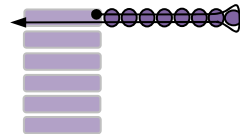
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3. Repeat step 2 until the band is the desired length of your bracelet minus your clasp.



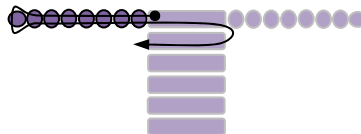
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4. Add one side of your clasp by threading through both holes and the last bugle added again. Repeat.



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5. Pick up 8 seed beads. Skipping the last bead added, pass back through the first 7 beads and through the bugle you were exiting at the beginning of this step.



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6. Repeat step 5. Pass through the next bugle in the strip.



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7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 to add seed bead fringes to both sides of each bugle bead in the strip. The number of beads in each fringe will follow this pattern: 8, 6, 4, 2, 4, 6, 8, etc.
8. Repeat step 4 to add the second half of your clasp.
9. Weave in your working and tail threads and trim.
